Most universities and colleges have entrance scholarships based on academic achievement that are given automatically upon program entrance. All others require students to apply making sure that they fulfill all the requirements.

Scholarships/Awards: can be based on entrance, grades, community service, or athletics

Bursaries/Grants: primarily based on financial need

Note: Students need to be mindful of the due dates and allow for adequate time (7-10 days) if assistance is needed.
