ELIGIBILITY

Available to current Secondary School students with written permission from his/her day school principal or designate (Grade 8 students entering Grade 9 in September 2018 are only eligible for ALC 101)

ATTENDANCE

Prompt, daily attendance is expected. Students who incur more than 3 absences in a course or 1.5 absences in a half credit/transfer course may be withdrawn.

FEES

- A book deposit of \$100.00 (cheque only) made payable to St. Charles is required on the first day of class for most credit courses. The cheque will be returned when the student returns the book in the same condition as when it was received.
- Foreign VISA students: Full credit course - \$1,307.00; Half credit course - \$653.00 (cash or certified cheque only), is payable in full at time of registration. Refunds only if we cancel the class.
- Students that damage or vandalise school property will be held responsible for any and all costs associated with their actions, and may also be subject to criminal charges.

COOP/OYAP/SHSM

Students may earn secondary school credits through cooperative education (Coop), the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) or Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM). Contact the guidance office at your high school for information.

HOW TO REGISTER

- 1) On-line registration at <http://coned.hwcdsb.ca>. Students of the Hamilton Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB) can register starting May 1 (please see Quick Reference Card (QRC) for instructions). Students of the Hamilton Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) and Adults can register starting June 1 by creating a new account. Print the permission form and bring it (signed by your Principal or designate) to the first day of class. E-learning students can bring their permission form to the orientation night.
 - 2) On-site registration will be held at the summer school sites on Tuesday July 3, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. and on the first day of class (July 4) for individuals that have NOT registered through their guidance office. Print the permission form from the St. Charles website and bring it (signed by your Principal or designate) with you to register.
- Adult students must provide their high school transcript and Citizenship or Immigration status to register.
 - If applicable, provide the Summer School office your Individual Education Plan (IEP) so we can better support your needs.
 - Cancellations will be posted on the St. Charles website July 3, 2018 (late afternoon / early evening).
 - Final report cards will be sent to your high school in August

TYPES OF PROGRAMS

Repeat Credit Courses

(Teacher-taught course codes end in “1” or “7”; e-learning** ends in “E”)

Repeat (upgrading) courses run the same duration as New credit.

New Credit Courses

(Teacher-taught course codes end in “1” or “7”, e-learning** ends in “E”)

Available to current grade 9-12 students taking the course for the first time.
