- Acquire confidence and self-reliance in a professional setting

## **Design of the Program**

**Duration-** the program runs Semester 1 and Semester 2.

**Schedule-** students will spend ½ of the day in school and ½ of the day at their work placement.

**Credits-** students will earn two credits. OYAP students earn 4 credits

**Pre-Placements Requirements-** a Coop student is required to have:

- A one on one interview with the coop teacher
- Parental approval
- A successful employer interview
- Provide an updated resume
- Successful completion of an in-school course related to placement.

## **How to sign up for coop**

**1<sup>st</sup>** – sign up for coop on your option sheet (OYAP is only selected by students who have already done Coop)

**2<sup>nd</sup>** – Listen to announcements. Early in March you will be called to a special meeting in the cafeteria where you will sign up for an interview with a coop teacher.

**3<sup>rd</sup>** – Have an updated resume ready
